Office of Congressmember Karen Bass 2017 Art Competition Rules and Regulations

FOR STUDENTS AND TEACHERS

General Information

- The competition is open to high school students only.
- Each artwork can be no larger in **size** than 26 inches high, 26 inches wide, and 4 inches deep.
- Accepted media for the two-dimensional artwork are as follows:
 - Paintings: oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.
 - Drawings: colored pencil, pencil, ink, marker, pastels, charcoal
 - Prints: lithographs, silkscreen, block prints
 - o Collages
 - Mixed Media
 - o Computer-generated art
 - Photographs
- Each entry must be **original in concept, design, and execution** and may not violate U.S. copyright laws. Any entry that has been copied from an existing photo or image (including a painting, graphic, or advertisement) that was created by someone other than the student is a violation of the competition rules.

Suitability and Content Guidelines

Congressmember Karen Bass welcomes student artwork of all kinds, including those addressing pressing issues of the day.

Student Information and Release Forms

- Each entrant must submit a Student Information and Release Form.
- The Form is available at https://bass.house.gov/services/art-competition.
- Request the form by email at <u>Bass.Art@mail.house.gov</u>.
- Copies of the flyer and the form can be provided in quantity by request.
- A copy of the Student Information and Release Form, completed as thoroughly as possible and signed by the teacher, a parent or guardian, and the student, **must be securely attached to the back of the artwork** to certify the originality of the piece.
- Students without a fixed address, in foster care or otherwise unable to complete a portion of the form are still eligible to enter. Teachers or students can contact the office for more information.
